## 2018-2019 Annual Report

Connaught School Council would like to thank the staff at the Ottawa-Carleton District School Board for its collaboration to renew the schoolyard at Connaught Public School. In September 2019, we opened the revitalized schoolyard which now features a new turf playing field as well as newly naturalized play and education areas. This opening marked the pinnacle of our Schoolyard Renewal Project, which also included the purchase of the new kindergarten play structure in 2017 and the Nature Education Centre in 2018.

Connaught School Council raised \$34,800<sup>1</sup> in 2018-2019. With a school population of 380 students, this amounts to about \$91 per student.

70% of raised funds went to the schoolyard renewal project, and the remaining 30% went towards:

- Reimbursing teacher expenses,
- Installing whiteboards in classrooms,
- Subsidizing field trips,
- Purchasing French reading material, and
- Supporting the Grade 6 leaving ceremony and overnight trip to MacSkimming Education Centre.

Connaught School Council's other major accomplishment of 2018-2019 was its advocacy to the City of Ottawa on the sudden closing of the Forward Family Shelter, located in our school catchment area. In December 2018, School Council representatives wrote to the Mayor, and appeared on CBC radio and television, in order to pressure the City to provide permanent housing for the affected families and allow more time for to make moving arrangements. Connaught School Council also collected and moved donations to fully furnish two of the affected families into their new homes.

In June 2019, Connaught School Council hosted its inaugural "Lawn It for Connaught" lawn-bowling fundraising event, which raised almost \$8,000. Due to its tremendous success, we plan to continue the event as an annual tradition, complementing our other ongoing fundraisers and community-building events: pizza days, Scholastic Book Fair, citrus sales, movie nights, multi-cultural potluck, pancake breakfast, Stone Soup Café, and end-of-year BBQ.
